



## 2. Getting to Zografus Camp

### Getting There

The **Zografou Campus** can be reached in the following ways:

1. With public means of transportation
2. With NTUA's mini-Bus
3. With private means

**In the first case**, the buses that serve the Zografou campus of NTUA are:

**608**

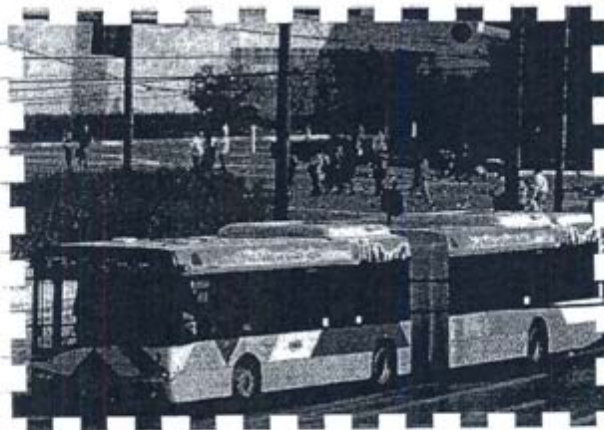
Bus number 608, Galatsi-Akadimia-Zografou line. For NTUA get off the bus at the '8th of Zografou' stop and walk to the "upper" gate of the campus, which is the one at Iroon Polytechniou 9, near the Lambadario building (Rural and Survey Engineering).

**230**

Bus number 230, Acropolis-Zografou line. For NTUA get off the bus at the '8th of Zografou' stop and walk to the "upper" gate of the campus, which is the one at Iroon Polytechniou 9, near the Lambadario building (Rural and Survey Engineering).

**242**

This is service that connects Katehaki St. (Metro) and NTUA Campus (and back). Only available on weekdays. It runs every 15 minutes, between 07:00 and 21:00 from Monday to Thursday and between 07:00 and 18:30 on Fridays



**140**

There is also the bus line (number) 140 for Polygono (Glyfada) which leaves from the Evelpidon Court of Law, and stops near the "lower" gate of the campus, on the cross of Katehaki Av. and Kokkinopoulou St. You can also get on

this bus at the intersection of Mesogeion Av. and Katehaki Av., where it also stops. The disadvantage in using this bus is that one has to walk for about 15 minutes, from the "lower" gate to the buildings of the campus. On the other hand, the advantage is that most of the cars pass through that gate and someone might give you a ride!

**In the second case**, the time table of NTUA's mini-bus is:

**In the third case**, you must keep in mind that cars (taxis or private) can enter the campus only through the entrance near Katehaki Avenue.

The **Patision Campus** can be reached in the following ways:

1. With public means of transportation

3. With private means

**In the first case**, you can opt to reach Omonoia metro station and walk along Patision Avenue (sometimes inscribed as "28th of October") to the North, or ride one of the many buses that go up and down the avenue. **Bus Services No. :**
